

Balance Sheet:

Other - Insurance and Guarantee Program Liabilities (Reserves): Reserves are \$227.2 million as of May 31, 2014; \$19.0 million is for specific natural person credit unions, and \$208.2 million is for general reserves.

Statement of Net Cost:

For the month ended May 31, 2014, the fund had net income of \$3.7 million. The fund recognized gross revenues of \$17.8 million and total operating expenses of \$14.0 million. The fund recognized a increase in insurance loss expense of \$0.1 million during the month of May 2014.






